



TITLE V TIP SHEET: Title V Information System

Title V Information System (TVIS) is an online site that provides data from State & Territorial Title V Maternal and Child Health programs:

- Block Grant Applications/Annual Reports, •
- Five-year Needs Assessments,
- Financial, program and performance/indicator data, and
- State-by-state, regional, and national composite data.

You can use the TVIS to learn more about the needs of the MCH population, including CYSHCN, in your state; the priorities your state Title V program is addressing, and how well your state is performing. The following links within the TVIS will help you find information you may need:

The narrative of each state's and territory's most recent Block Grant application is provided in pdf or html format. The narratives can be over 200 pages and provide details on how public input was gathered, needs assessment summary, capacity of Title V to meet needs, state priorities, performance measures, health status indicators, budget narrative, and various attachments.

(Note - these may be several hundred pages in length; the most current needs assessments are from 2010. Needs assessments are again due with the 2015 Block Grant applications.)

National Data: Aggregated data on national performance measures, health systems capacity indicators and health status indicators reflecting key indicators of maternal and child health systems and program capacity. State Data: State specific performance and outcome measures that gauge progress on state-specific goals, including priority needs, performance, and outcome measures.

Data is provided nationally or by state on individuals served, health screening, Medicaid/Non-Medicaid, Medicaid and CHIP eligibility. Reports can compare states.
