- Describe the target population of families of CYSHCN to be served
- Specific needs for families in accessing services as ID'ed by families & key stakeholders
- Socio-cultural determinants of health & health disparities
- Documentation of unmet needs
- Needs related to health insurance & improving outcomes
- Demographic data of population to be served including geographic, economic, racial/ethnic, & linguistic data
- Quantitative & qualitative data
- Data from past activities

PROCESS, TOOLS, AND SOURCES FOR NEEDS ASSESSMENT

- CDC Social Vulnerability Index:
[CDC/ATSDR's Social Vulnerability Index \(SVI\)](#)
 - The CDC/ATSDR SVI uses **U.S. Census data** to determine the social vulnerability of every census tract. Census tracts are subdivisions of counties for which the Census collects statistical data. The CDC/ATSDR SVI ranks each tract on **15 social factors**, including poverty, lack of vehicle access, & crowded housing.

- Methodology
 - Helping families make informed choices
 - Providing information
 - Identifying successful healthcare delivery models
 - Developing models for collaborations
 - Providing training & guidance
 - Conducting outreach
 - Staffing by families & health professionals
- Additional activities: Address
 - Partnerships
 - Plan for developing a diversity & inclusion plan
 - Collection, monitoring, analysis, & reporting on data
 - Meaningful support & collaboration with key stakeholders in planning, designing, & implementing all activities, including extent to which contributors reflect the cultural, racial, linguistic, & geographic diversity of populations & communities

ADDRESSING EQUITY & DISPARITIES IN OTHER AREAS

- Evaluation Plan – strategies to:
 - Identify/use appropriate data sources, collect & analyze data that measure outcomes
 - Collect, analyze, & track data to measure outcomes of different socio-cultural groups (race, ethnicity, language)
 - Monitor & evaluate efficiency of project activities/process
 - How data will be used to inform & improve quality of program development & service delivery
- Organizational Information
 - Organizational mission, vision, structure, scope of activities
 - Proven & successful leadership role in areas covered by F2Fs
 - Staffed by families with expertise in required areas, & health professionals
 - Organization chart
 - Staffing plan
 - Resources and capabilities to support provision of culturally and linguistically competent health literacy services
