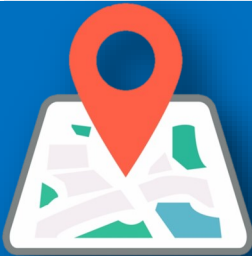

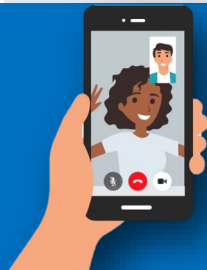
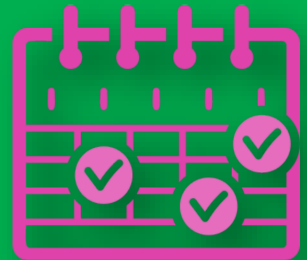


HELP FINDING LOCAL VACCINATION LOCATIONS

Monitor vaccination clinic accessibility for people with disabilities. Ensure that each vaccination provider site has a point of contact to address reasonable accommodation needs for older adults and people with disabilities.
