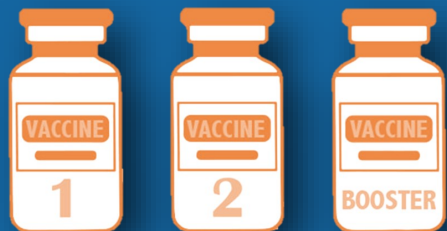

BOOST THE BOOSTER



The FDA authorized a second booster dose offered by Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna COVID-19

WHAT TO KNOW

A second booster dose of the COVID-19 Vaccine may be administered at least 4 months after the first booster dose.

A second booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine could help increase protection levels for higher-risk individuals.

Booster doses protect individuals both from infection and severe outcomes of COVID-19

WHO CAN GET A BOOSTER AND A SECOND BOOSTER

Pfizer-BioNTech

- Everyone 12 years and older—5 months after completing your first vaccine series
- Adults 50 years and older—If eligible, at least 4 months after your first booster.

Moderna

- Adults 18 years and older—At least 5 months after completing your first vaccine series
- Adults 50 years and older—4 months after your first booster.

Johnson & Johnson's Janssen

- Adults 18 years and older—At least 2 months after receiving your J&J/Janssen COVID-19 vaccination.
- Anyone who received a J&J/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine for both their primary dose and booster. If eligible, at least 4 months after your first booster.
- Adults 50 years and older who first received a J&J/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine, regardless of what type of booster they received.
