What is My Language, My Care?

My Language, My Care is an online training course about language access in the health care setting. This course for families will help increase awareness, understanding, and use of language access services for families whose preferred language is not English.

The self-paced course is available in English, Spanish, American Sign Language, and Chinese and can be completed in about 4 hours. After completing the course, participants receive a certificate.
