American Academy of Pediatrics President Dr. Susan J. Kressly says, "There is no single root cause of autism and there is no single medication that will give every autistic child or adult what they need." **Family Voices stands behind strong, evidence-based science**. People with autism and disabilities must be a part of the ongoing research and discussions around their communities.
